### AQUARIUS (Jan. 20 – Feb. 18)

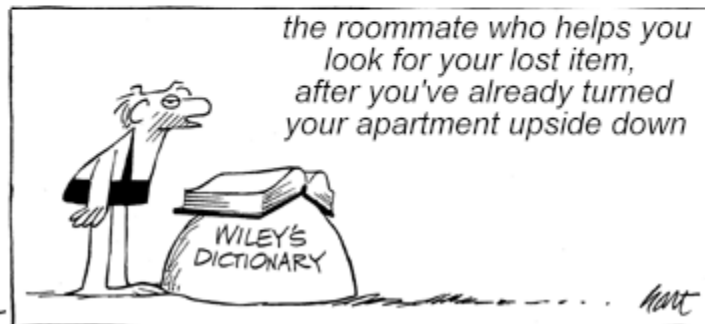
