Anna Brees interviews Dr. Roger Hodkinson - 11 June, 2021

AB Hello everyone, it is the 11th of June, 2021 and I am talking to Dr. Roger Hodkinson again, for the third time, with a very important matter. We were chatting on the phone just a few minutes ago, Roger, and I thought it was incredibly important, that I got you on this call, because there is a really urgent message, isn't there, for the public?

Tell me first of all, for those who haven't heard about you before, ah, what's your experience, what do you do, who are you?

RH In summary, I'm a retired pathologist living in Canada. I was trained at Cambridge in the UK, in medicine, and then in pathology in Vancouver, British Columbia. I have been an assistant professor at the faculty of medicine at the University of Alberta. I've been chair of the examination committee of general pathology at the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons in Ottawa. I've been the CEO of a large commercial laboratory. I am currently the chairman of an American company involved in molecular diagnostics, DNA sequencing for early diagnosis of cancer, so I've had a well-rounded career, and I think I am quite competent to comment on many aspects of Jumbled.

AB And you are not a lone voice, and I keep saying to people, you know, there's [Dr. Swiko ?] with ethics, you've got [Panding ?], you've got Hart, you've got the Frontline American Doctors [America's Frontline Doctors¹]. And then maybe a few doctors in [Mayo?] you are not too sure about. You know in terms of [...Jumbled...]

RH I am part of, you might say, the inner circle. There's about 12 of us internationally, that converse on a regular basis, off line. And I did have a conversation by email with [Dr.] Peter McCullough which we'll talk about in a minute. The preeminent American cardiologist involved in, in COVID, and um, so, yeah. I've been in the thick of it. I am extremely frustrated with what's going on. And, I am sure we will talk about that.

AB Well what I said at the beginning of this interview, is you have a really urgent message to get out to the public. So what is it?

RH Well, the, this of course is an experimental vaccine. It should never have been released. It was never an emergency which predicated the development of the vaccine. And as with all vaccines, and there are complications, which were predictable. With time, but there

was never enough time given for the clinical trial which only lasted 4 to 6 months. In particular, complications are now coming out that are now very disturbing. The latest one, over the last few days, starting off in Israel, is the frequency of myocarditis in young adult males. And getting worse, the younger they are, in teenagers. Just so I can translate that, myocarditis is a medical term for inflammation of the heart. Now the CDC is calling this reality of a large number of these events, we are now up to over 200 events in the United States, recorded. The CDC is calling this, and quote “unbalanced” realisation. Well you are damn right it is unbalanced. It the CDC that’s unbalanced. Myocarditis is never mild, as they are describing it, as they are describing it, for the general public, meaning not terribly significant. The heart muscles, the cells that make up the heart muscles never regenerate. If one dies, they’re done. It’s not like the liver or the kidney, that regenerates. When a heart muscle dies, it is dead, and it’s never replaced. Myocarditis, means a generalised inflammation of the heart muscle. So, muscle cells in the heart will be dying. The number is hard to determine, obviously, because the person is still alive. But I can tell you categorical certainty, supported by Dr. McCullough’s conversation with me this morning, that myocarditis is totally unpredictable in terms of its long term consequences. It may only present, 20 years later, (because of the reserve of the heart) having been destroyed. We are talking here about cardiac arrhythmia developments, abnormal heart beats. We are talking about heart failure, and so on. This is a most, worrying development, and of course it is exactly the kind of complication that would have come out of a normal clinical trial, for a vaccine, which typically takes a couple of years. But of course...

AB Why did you, why did you speak to Dr. Peter McCullough? Where do you go at the moment when you are getting all this information and reports from all over the world. Um, you said you were in a group of 12. Where do you go? Where’s the expertise. How can we be sure that what you are saying is something for us to take note of?

RH Well, um, Dr. McCullough has his own group, in the United States, that I follow very carefully. I am in communication, he is the lead of it, and I am in frequent communication with him. In Europe Doctors For COVID Ethics², which is headed up by **Dr. Sucharit Bhakdi**, and [Dr. Mayeden ?] and Dr Michael Palmer. All with substantial reputations in their own fields. And then in South Africa there’s Panda, headed up by Nick Hudson, with his own, esteemed scientific advisory board. So, you know, I am as plugged in as anyone can be. We’re all in frequent communication with zoom calls every week.

And that's, I speaking therefore with some authority on this, and connected, on a daily basis, with the top guys in the world.

AB But I need to challenge you here. Because you are 12, or small groups, but there must be thousands and thousands of doctors who completely disagree with you. Or are there, is there something that is keeping them quiet? I mean why should we listen to you and why is it so important, in terms, your experience within these groups?

RH Let me assure you that the statistics when the books are written will be exactly the other way round. I suspect, and it's impossible to confirm because of the intimidation that colleges across the world are putting on individual physicians, including me. I can assure you that there are, there is a vast number of physicians who do not buy into this idiocy. Physicians who are well-trained can see through this, immediately, as transparently stupid. It is medical idiocy of the most grotesque degree, that's going on. None of the so-called mandates, first of all, supported by any scientific consensus whatsoever. If there had been one, we would have used it in previous flu epidemics. And we never did. You simply can't solve these things by any controlled, you can't solve the spread of a pandemic with an upper respiratory tract virus, by any known means to medical science. It's simply not possible. As per the ...

AB Well, the message that will reach the public that maybe sitting on the fence, those are the people I want to reach. What I found interesting is that when I have been listening to these doctors, they were actually recommending the vaccination in January, in February, and March, and even I wasn't getting any emails whatsoever for a journalist who has quite a high profile in this situation. I wasn't getting any stories about this vaccine reaction, but something shifted about six weeks ago. And so these doctors were recommending it to patients, but they've changed, completely changed their minds and said, we must halt this immediately. So it's not that you are in a movement in any way. You were promoting the vaccine and Dr. Mike Eden talked about vaccinating the vulnerable, but over the last, I don't know, two months, they've pulled back and said, actually no we need to hold back. We no longer recommend this for our patients.

RH Tess Laurie is the most authoritative person on this. And she's just published a devastating analysis of the whole mess, with the bottom line being exactly that. That this vaccination of everybody should stop immediately. Remember please, that the predicate for this vaccine, or these vaccines was the statement that this was a medical emergency of a most sinister global scale. Well it never was, by any definition. And so if you take

away that underpinning requirement, if you take away the emergency, there was absolutely no reason for the development, for the development for a vaccine that contravened all the normal safe guards for the introduction of something of such a global scale. There's never been, ever, in medical history, a vaccination program on this scale involving billions of people, with the most minor attention to long-term consequences. And I, I do want to expand on that, because the story is not yet over. Look, last time I checked, pregnancy takes nine months. You cannot conceivably check for fertility issues if you are only doing a clinical trial for four to six months, that never even included pregnant women other than those that got pregnant during the trial. And there were only 40 of them. There are very serious scientific possibilities here for long-term infertility. The studies have not been done. We do know for a fact that the placenta and the testes are, have a very heavy expression of the receptor for the spike protein, which is being produced in large amounts by the vaccines. We do know that. We also know that during the SARS epidemic, which was a very similar organism, there were, there were reports a small number, it was a small number of people that came down with it obviously. It was well-contained. But we do know that during the SARS epidemic was reports of orchitis which is a medical term for inflammation of the testis. So what I'm saying is, on the male side of fertility, there are serious scientific grounds for worry, not proven, I'm not being a scaremonger here. I'm not a conspiracy theorist. I am not an anti-vaxer, de-dah, de-dah, right. I take vaccines myself. On the female side, there is equal concern, because it comes out of the obscure Pfizer submission to the Japanese regulatory authority, that the vaccine particles, the tiny lipid nano particles that are part of the vaccine, locate very heavily in the ovary. Now this was a rat study, but it still showed heavy localisation, most unexpectedly, of these vaccine particles in the ovary.

AB You need to explain, because I am not a scientist, and the audience watching, what does this mean when the ovaries attaches? What does that exactly mean?

RH Well, it means we don't know what it means. That's what it means. Because, all I am saying is there is scientific evidence in the literature for concern about the consequences of the vaccine targeting the ovaries, and the spike protein targeting the testis. That is in the literature, I'm not making this up. It's there in the literature. If it's there in the literature, it needs to be excluded as a possible long-term complication. And you can't do that unless you check fertility issues over a number of years.

AB OK. So, I need to think about my audience, and the people who are going to be watching this. Do they, say, safer to wait? Something that lots of celebrities and even journalists are

getting behind here in the UK. Is it safer to wait or is it wait till the phase three trials are over, 2023.

RH What do celebrities know about this? They've got nothing between the ears. For God's sake, get a grip on your selves. I'm telling you that this is very serious problem.

AB I am telling you we have the great Barrington interview, I've interviewed you, I interviewed Mike Yeadon³ ⁴, and nothing seems to be getting through. So that's why I am going to celebrities. [Jumbled.]

AB It's horrific.

RH I don't mean you, Anna Brees, I mean, I mean 'you', the 'general public', the 'politicians', the 'people driving the bus'. Get a grip on yourselves.

AB We don't know.

RH This is serious medical science. And you're mucking around with billions of people's health for the most tenuous of reasons and it's totally and utterly unacceptable. When it comes to injecting this stuff into the arms of children, I call it state-sanctioned child abuse, of the most monstrous scale. It is utterly unacceptable and it should stop immediately.

AB I am trying to save, um, you know, this is going to be very personal now, but I have a 12 year old, um. And the dad and I separated and I know he really looks up to, he's on Tik Tok and youtube and google and he listens to all those adverts on social media, and I'm worried he is going to think this is safe. This is the way, he's gonna have the vaccine. I want to ask you what is happening in Canada, because it looks like they are going to start vaccinating children here in the UK. [Jumbled] But, but, but that causes sleepless nights for me. But it causes sleepless nights for me that it is happening all over the world, and um, it's really important that we say, the same response, so in Canada, what's happening with the kids?

RH In my own province of Alberta, as of 2 days ago, when I last checked the statistics, one third of all teenagers are being vaccinated with the first shot. This is a matter of supreme urgency. We could be seeing the most catastrophic long-term consequences. Quite apart from the blood clots that are in the brain and the legs. Quite apart from fertility issues.

Myocarditis. Serious, long-term possible complications of this utter madness. If, if you are going to introduce something on such a global scale, without the appropriate precautions of a normal clinical trial, you as government should be obligated, before that happens, to put in place a most meticulous monitoring system to sample people who've been vaccinated, to determine the true incidence of these complications. That has not happened. They are not just culpable in just what they are, they are culpable in not monitoring what they are introducing because it was introduced as an emergency. And furthermore, if it is in fact an emergency, as they claim, which it's not, by any stroke of the imagination, it's merely a bad seasonal flu which is unfortunately killing the elderly people in greater numbers than the flu - that's it. But if it is an emergency, and therefore you are introducing this, this insane vaccination program, then by the same token the [dosh?] should be taken off individual physicians to allow them to prescribe agents that may prevent the disease, and certainly may make the disease less severe if it develops. And I am talking about Ivermectin and Hydroxychloroquine.

AB [Jumbled.] And you know, I have spoken to Dr Pierre Kory ^{5 6 7 8}, he said Ivomectin is a bridge to the vaccine. We could use Ivermectin until the safety trials are over. Roger, I have to ask you, you know, there's a children's program here on the BBC called BBC News-round. And there's doctors who say the vaccine is safe, um, and they are encouraging people to take it. But they are, you know, in bigger numbers than you guys. There's all of these doctors, if this is they're wrong, who are they? What are they talking about? Are they mad? [Jumbled.] Is there somebody blackmailing them? You know, they have kids.

RH They are culpable of extreme medical malpractice. There are two underpinning ethics. First do no harm. We are seeing that play out in spades now, with all these complications. And the second one, with respect to vaccination, is informed consent. There is no informed consent, because they are not being told that this is unsafe. The bill boards one word. Four letters. Unqualified. SAFE. That's a contortion of medical language. It's Orwellian.

- AB How is it possible that so many doctors are very, very happy to promote this vaccination to children, that it's safe? How is that possible?
- RH You are only hearing the one's are kowtowing to government and the colleges because of their positions in academia, and the regulatory bodies. These are people who simply want to tick off the box on their CV to say that we had this position and that position, and that position. And they only got to those positions because they were always brown-nosing the person ahead of them.
- AB But they vaccinated their own children, some of them.
- RH That's that's their own decision to make. What I am saying is, that these idiots in the health profession, are merely trying to comply with the, the, the demands of the people around them or above them. The people who you should be speaking to of course are the silent majority of physicians who are being intimidated, brutally, into silence. These colleges, these regulatory bodies are there to do one thing, and one thing only, to protect the general public from us. That's their job. To make sure we are not paedophiles, we are not having sex with our patients. We are not cutting off the wrong leg. That is their job. So their job should extend to demanding of governments, pounding the table, saying why are you doing this? It is medical negligence of the highest order. It's causing more hurt than benefit and there is no informed consent. Instead of that, instead of being neutral and independent, and protecting the public, they are the enforcer of government...
- AB How is that possible? You are talking of hundreds and hundreds and thousands of doctors. How is that possible?
- RH Because these colleges and regulatory bodies as I said, are populated by do-gooders, by people that just wanted to tick off the box on their CV. They're not representative of medicine at large. Not all all. You speak to the average physician. They do not have a very high regard for their own colleges because they, ah, consider the colleges to be oppressive. Look, where are these colleges, where are these colleges when the chips are down? They're not banging the table with governments on COVID. Where were they on marijuana? You speak to an average physician on marijuana, no one's in favour of it really. They saluted in government's general direction. Where are they on tobacco? Tobacco is killing half a million in the United States, every year. A public health crisis as big as a proportion every year, as COVID is, if you believe their death certificates, which are of course, exaggerated. These colleges have become woke. They are not protecting the public good any more. They are simply the enforcers of government.

- AB It's more serious than that. What you are saying is they are supporting, um, a procedure and a program that harms children. That is very.. [Unintelligible.]
- RH Very much so. And that is the in, that is despicable. It is medical negligence of the highest order, to be agreeing that government wants you to do that you know is harmful.
- AB Do they only know it's harmful though? Because we have a huge problem in here Roger. When I put you on youtube, it was removed within ten minutes. I can't put you on Facebook and Twitter. I did put you on Twitter and I put a boost of my own money. A boost means that it goes higher up in the feed. So I put 700 or 900 dollars on it, and it reached 200,000 people on Facebook. I'm so glad I did it while I could. It's all about doing it when you can. And we reached 200,000 people on Facebook but then a week later it was called misinformation. Do they actually hear your voice? Do they know your voice? Are you messaging them, and you emailing them? Because it's not on the BBC, it's not on Facebook, it not, on Youtube. Do they know whatever the evidence is that you are presenting? Have you ...
- RH The censorship, the worst censorship of course is with physicians. That is the ultimate resource of trust and reliable information to the general public. But the other sources, you're well aware of are being equally censored in a brutal fashion. The media, the mainstream media, of course, is not running anything. At least in Canada, the reason is because the Prime Minister has bribed them into silence. He's actually giving them billions of dollars to support their activities and of course they don't bite the hand that feeds you. Do you?
- AB Well how much money do you need. I mean, right from the beginning, my freedom is the most precious in my whole life, you know. I wear secondhand clothes that are from the charity shop. I go to Liddles to shop. It's cheap. You know. I could pay the bills. What do you need this money for? What is more important than children? I don't understand how you could be bribed by money. You know, your reputation, in, ah, your professionalism surely, your, integrity, is the most precious thing you have. The most precious commodity anyone could ever have.
- RH Politicians want to control the media. And they have done it, very successfully in Canada by bribing them. And of course, social media is censoring that is not palatable to the, those Facebook, and ...

AB A huge thing has happened here, for me Richard. Let me just share this with the public. I, I was always always championing youtube and twitter and facebook and new media and what I've seen has shocked me from these platforms. And I am actually getting, um, much greater relationships of trust with a number of, I call them whistle blowers, or journalists, that are insiders, so. There's three at the Telegraph, there's about four at the BBC. And we've got the Sunday Express, you've got the Mail. These are the people now that are getting stuff out. So I can't share your interview on my platform but I can share it with these journalists and they are listening. And we are getting somewhere. It's probably a little bit of a different picture, here in the UK. But I called on media, but these journalist who are, they are good people. They are really good people. And I speak to them directly, now, you know. If you work in the BBC, the Telegraph, the Mail, Sky News, ITV, you I know there is issues within your media organisation. You are, listening to people to Dr. Roger Hodkinson and you know you have to act. I really do call out to you now. I've got a whats upp group that I'm in with a number of these journalists and we are sharing ideas and we are going to make a huge difference. We are going to do what we can. But unfortunately, I see these big guys, the Google and the twitter and the facebook have really let us down. I can't share what I need to share any more. Um, so I see, what I can do is that, as especially Roger here in the UK, you've got regional newspapers. And they have all gone online. So you've got one down in Devon, and Exeter. I know you went to Cambridge. And they do share stories, so the BBC presenter Lisa Shaw⁹ who was 44 who died after the AstraZeneca vaccine, that was shared by the BBC actually. And those stories do get out. I can share those on Twitter, but I can't share a story. If I talk to family, even though I'm an ex- BBC / ITV presenter, if I share that on Twitter on Facebook. I will just get removed. But I can share these old media, traditional media brands, and their stories. And what I would say is that BBC presenter, Lisa Shaw, she was 44. She was a mother. The only, I contacted um a mainstream media publication. I said are you gonna run this, cause as I knew it was a story that was breaking, four days before. They said we can't touch it. We cannot touch it. And then a week later, I said, have you run the story. Yes. The only reason we could run this story is because the BBC had to run the story. And the reason the BBC had to run the story about that presenter, Lisa Shaw, was because the family were going to talk. There were colleagues. I put pressure on the BBC. There were colleagues that were colleagues that were going to speak out, and the family

members. And the BBC had to run it. And then, only did the others^{10 11 12}. And it's not, people with your experience, um. It's not about that any more. It's about brands and trust and the media. It's, you know, I've tried to get you on the High Wire^{13 14}, and Fox News. It's media strategy now, isn't it. I know you're frustrated and a lot of these communication groups that we are in. What's, um your media strategy Rodger Hodgkinson? What do you intend to do? Because this message sounds urgent.

RH Well, I. The way I describe it is you can't confront a juggernaut with a pea shooter. There are lots of terribly well-meaning physicians, and scientists, that I'm talking to on a regular basis, as I described. But, even they, with their organisations, I'm talking about Doctors for COVID Ethics. I am talking about PANDA ^{15 16 17 18 19 20} in South Africa. I'm talking about Peter McCullough. Peter McCullough probably gets the best penetration of anyone. Um, in terms of American media. Um, but even that is limited. I do think, Anna, that, um, you know, the old story the 'truth will out'. There must be, right now, as we are speaking, investigative journalists who are about to be coming out with a torrent of the most ...

AB You talk about the penetration of all media. Sorry to interrupt you Roger. The Great Barrington Declaration. Professor Martin Caldorf. They penetrated the old media.

RH Yes.

AB Investigative journalists are not usually hired. They are not staff. They sell their stories. I'm..

RH I talking about books. You can't suppress books. There will be, there must be, as we speak, the likes **Alex Berenson**, for example ^{21 22 23 24 25 26 27}. There will be books being written as we speak, for the widest distribution on Amazon, that condemns, in the strongest possible terms, this entire, mad episode in human history. And, heads will roll. There will be blood in the gutter. And that is going to happen very, very soon. Because something as crazy as this, something as so gigantically mad, cannot be suppressed. The truth will out. And when it does. So many people will such, they will be seen for what they are. The emperor has no clothes. These colleges will be massively changed in terms of how they address the public, their obligation to the general public. So many people are culpable here. Politicians. Regulatory bodies. Media. Positions, individual positions. Everyone in that group is culpable of the most terrible crime ever committed on humanity. It is on that scale. And I am not exaggerating here. I've got my head screwed on. I know exactly what is going on. And it's absolutely tragic.

AB Maybe, maybe it might not be in our lifetime, Roger. But we have done our best, I think. And we can sleep at night. When we talk about books. I really need to plug Laura Dodsworth, the State of Fear. It has been mentioned by many politicians. It is a Sunday Times best seller, and I really do recommend, here in the UK. **Laura Dodsworth**²⁸. It's been selling out. **State of Fear**. She is fantastic. A really excellent book for anyone looking to read a little bit more. Like you say. Amazon might not, promote the books. That is the issue that we have. You know, you go on to google, and ah, wikipedia, and you look up Dr. Roger Hodkinson, or Anna Brees, and it might tell you something, that we are not particularly happy about. But I know that, people feel uncomfortable. And I have seen a Sunday Times, sorry the Times columnist, and I have also seen a Guardian columnist speaking out, about this vaccinating kids issues. Because a lot of these journalists are

parents. And, ah, they were happy to get the vaccine, and they've had it, and they know about the reactions in parents. But when it comes to their own children, but they are starting to talk, but they are doing it in a really kind of managed way. Which I find is really, really, it makes me feel uncomfortable. They are trying to keep some kind of professionalism. It's like, oh, I er, will look at this, but of course, I always, it's just always, it makes me feel very uncomfortable, that there is a lack of honesty. But, I will think you will see more and more people coming out now, because these reports are coming from Israel, about very serious issues with respect to the vaccination of the, um. Is it too late for these people to rescue their reputation, Roger. I'll ask you that now.

RH Is it what sorry?

AB Is it too late for people to come out and rescue their reputations, if they have done stuff in the past that feel uncomfortable about?

RH Not at all. I, recommend to any politicians listening to me. I recommend just the opposite. The evidence is so overwhelming, that now is the time for a leader to put his or her standard in the ground and say, I was wrong. I was led astray by my advisors who were giving me terrible information to act upon. And in politics, if you take that brave step, many people will forgive you, for honesty. And your star can actually rise, for the next election. There is a golden opportunity in Canada for that, because of the, the terrible draconian things that are happening. Let me just tell you just one thing that I heard of yesterday at a rally where I gave a speech. One of the most prominent politicians in this country, he could have actually been Prime Minister if he had run the leadership race, for the conservative party. His name **Max Bernea**. Max Bernea was planning to give a speech in Winnipeg, in Manitoba. And he was told, by the regulatory, government departments, that regulates all this activity, and so on. As one of the most prominent politicians in the country, he was told this. Not only can you not give a speech at this rally, but I am telling you, you will self-quarantine in your hotel, until you leave. Period. Now that's one of the most senior politicians in this country. And they are trying to intimidate him. Of course he is not going to comply. But they are trying to intimidate everyone, at every level. Politics included. We didn't cover politics by the way. In my own province, the premier of this province, is intimidating the politicians in his party that they cannot, underlined, even meet with me to hear evidence to the contrary. Even to meet to hear information. Otherwise you will be kicked out of the party, you may lose the next election, and with that goes your pension. Are you listening to me? Knock, knock. Hello. At every level, there is intimidation, in politics and in medicine.

AB And it's sort of based on reputation and having an income, and we have all got to think about, yeah of course we have to put food on the table and protect our kids, and have a roof over our head. What I would say, Roger, is we in the conversation is, if you are watching this wherever you are in the world, I hope you have a great audience in UK and Canada. You know, I can't share this anywhere other than, ah Telegram. But you can. You can download this video, you put it on Youtube, Facebook and Twitter. It can go viral. Um, I would suggest that you do that. I am trying my very best here, I am very congruent though. I'm a mother. I am not an activist or campaigner, but I see a very important message and a counter narrative that I have a duty to share with the wider population. And it's your duty if you are watching this. I really do say, it's so important, [Jumbled]. Sorry carry on Richard.

RH I'd like, you are showing this to a privileged audience of journalists who wish to know more about me. The best interview, long interview that I have done recently, in addition to yours, with with a journalist **Taylor Hudka**, who runs **The Last American Vagabond**²⁹. It's alternative media site. It has been getting exceptional reviews. And it covers the waterfront of um, of COVID. So I would recommend that your journalist friends actually.

AB She doesn't get as emotional as me. I don't know if she is a man, but she doesn't get as emotional as me. I get too emotional, Roger. I get upset, um.

RH Thank God you are, ah, emotional, Anna. There's a need for emotion here. People need to communicate that. This is not just an abstract, another news story. No. This is the biggest story ever of our times. And I so admire your leadership, your bravery, your personal consequences it has made to you. It's, its admirable, and it's a tragedy that journalist at large are not following your example. You're a, you're a tremendous leader, Anna. And I deeply admire you.

AB And so are you my friend. And so are you. And, ah, I apologise to the audience for trying my best to remain objective. But my face says I am congruent, I am a mother, and I feel pain, I actually feel pain. And um, I'm upset but it's who I am. And I worry about these kids all over the world. And we've got to do something, so, um. We'll end the interview there. Thank you for talking to me. You take care.

RH Thank you again Anna. Stay well, and it's been a pleasure. Thank you.
