

HOW TO REACH OAXACA FROM MEXICO CITY BY BUS

The duration is approximately between 6 and 9 hours, depending on the highway.

There are three different companies of buses, ALL located in

1. Terminal TAPO: Zaragoza No. 200, San Lázaro.
2. Terminal Central del Norte: Av. Cien Metros 4097.

How to reach the terminal TAPO from the airport of Mexico City

1. Taxi (Authorized taxi)	1. Exit the customs inspection area turn to your left and see the counter with a sign "Sitio 300" from which you will prepay your fare to your destination (Terminal TAPO) 2. After you purchase your ticket walk outside to the line of authorized taxi's "Taxi terrestre", enter the taxi and then hand your prepaid ticket to the driver who will hand you back your receipt portion.
2. Metro http://www.metro.df.gob.mx/	1. Walk through the entire terminal until you reach the exit at the far end of <i>Terminal A</i> and continue to walk for about a long city block until you see the

Change to Line 1 (pink) Pantitlán > Observatorio.4. Get off the metro at the sixth stop “San Lázaro”.
