Directions

UW is located in the twin cities of Kitchener-Waterloo in southwestern Ontario, about 90 minutes' drive west of Toronto or three hours east of Windsor-Detroit.

- From Highway 401 take Exit 278 (from Toronto) or Exit 278B (from London) to Highway 8 West, Kitchener
- From Buffalo and Niagara Falls, follow Queen Elizabeth Way in the "Toronto" direction to highway 403 West (one hour); follow 403 West to 6 North to 401 West to exit 278 (45 minutes)
- Follow 8 West to 7 East (an expressway called the Conestoga Parkway). Be sure to take the exit for 7 East, not 7 West
- Keep left. Do not exit on 7 East (Victoria Street and Guelph). Expressway becomes 85 North (formerly 86)
- Exit at University Avenue West and drive about 2 miles (3 km) until you reach the entrance to the University of Waterloo at University Avenue and Seagram Drive. Major streets you will cross as you drive along University Avenue are: Weber Street, King Street and Albert Street
- Turn right into the University
