What's new with the network?

- Wireless:
 - 80% of users migrated to eduroam
 - March 1 phase-out of uw-wireless not happening, uw-wireless to be renamed to uw-unsecured
 - “XpressConnect” configuration tool renewed
 - Private AP naming convention to help distinguish bogus SSIDs

...and

- IP address space cleanup
 - Using 10.15.0.0/23 network to “park” DNS names – non-functional (not routed)
 - Stale/unused addresses cleaned up, parked in 10.15.{75,75,78,77}/24

- Usage:

Other networking notes

- NetScreen firewall at end-of-life, to be replaced with a pair of Juniper SRX
 - Under the new network-management arrangement, provided by and managed by IST
 - Day-to-day policy management to be determined, probably to be CSCF
- Campus VPN is a Cisco ASA hardware solution, to be available “soon”
