Amount of Work Done: Relative to all other group members, how much work did each person do? Note: This score is relative to all other members of the group. If every member did the same amount of work, everyone would score 3 = Average.

Quality of Work Done: For the work that each member of the group did, was that work done well? This is not meant to be relative to other members of the group (e.g., all members could score above or below average).

Contribution of Ideas: Did the group member contribute ideas, were they good ideas and were they ultimately used? This is not meant to be relative to other members of the group (e.g., all members could score above or below average).

Quality as Group Member: Did the group member contribute to a positive environment? For example, did they communicate well and in a timely manner, did they help foster a supportive environment, and did they provide other members of the group with opportunities to participate. This is not meant to be relative to other members of the group (e.g., all members could score above or below average).
