### Some Characteristics of Numerology

- disregarding or mixing of units (e.g., years with feet)
- dependence on base-10 representation
- focus on shape of number when written
- insignificant coincidences elevated ("law of small numbers")
- assignment of meanings to specific numbers ("13 is unlucky")
- use of invented units (e.g., "pyramid inch")
- tweaking results to get the desired result
- unfalsifiability


#### The Koran and the Number 19


- it has 6 x 19 suras (chapters)

Ascii Code: A = 97, B = 98, C = 99, etc.



ROMNEY = 666

Code: A = 106, B = 107, C = 108, etc.



BARACK = 666

### 666: The "Number of the Beast"

Code: A = I, B = 2, C = 3, etc.

Barack Hussein Obama II = 181 + 435 + 50 = 666

Willard Mitt Romney = 231 + 435 = 666






# Numerology in Physics



Mohamed El Naschie, "On John Nash's crumpled surface", Chaos, Solitons, and Fractals 18 (2003), 635-641:

"The Hausdorff dimension [of the Menger sponge] is given by  $D_{MS} = \ln 20/\ln 3 = 2.7268$ . Note that the COBE temperature of microwave background ratio is found to be Tc(COBE) =  $D_{MS}$  K = 2.726 K."

# Numerology in Physics




Arthur Eddington, 1938: thought the fine-structure constant was exactly 1/136, and the number of protons in the universe was exactly 136·2<sup>256</sup>.

Arthur Eddington, 1946: thought the fine-structure constant was exactly 1/137.

Today's best estimate:  $\alpha = 1/137.035999084(51)$





This one seems to be a coincidence.



# Eschatology: Harold Camping



Camping patiently explained how he reached his conclusion for May 21, 2011.

"Christ hung on the cross April I, 33 A.D.," he began. "Now go to April I of 2011 A.D., and that's 1,978 years."

Camping then multiplied 1,978 by 365.2422 days - the number of days in each solar year...

# David Stove on Numerology

"[N]o one actually knows, even, what is wrong with numerology. Philosophers, of course, use numerology as a stock example of thought gone hopelessly wrong, and they are right to do so; still, they cannot tell you what it is that is wrong with it. If you ask a philosopher this, the best he will be able to come up with is a bit of Positivism about unverifiability, or a bit of Popperism about unfalsifiability: answers which the philosopher himself will know to be unsatisfactory on various grounds, but which have in addition this defect, that they put numerology in the same boat as, for example, astrology. But numerology is actually quite as different from astrology as astrology is from astronomy." -- David Stove, "What Is Wrong With Our Thoughts?", chapter 7 of The Plato Cult and Other Philosophical Follies (Blackwell, 1991).
